WHAT IS THE COLLIN COUNTY JUNIOR LIVESTOCK SHOW?

Each year PISD FFA members exhibit their projects and compete against other Collin County FFA members and 4-H members. At the conclusion of the show, the judge selects the top third of the project to go into premium sale. Some of the projects are: steers, heifers, lambs, swine, goats, broilers, rabbits, Ag mechanics, and floral. This is often the first taste of entrepreneurship the students receive.
